"In this talk, the students learn what they've been taught in school isn't necessarily the truth! They experience simple mathematical "facts" being turned on their heads by changing the context in which they appear. Through kinesthetic activities and demonstrations, they see that $2+2$ isn't always 4^* , that triangles aren't what they thought they were*, that cutting a bagel in half does not necessarily separate it, that some squares have negative area*, and that it is possible to divide by 0^* ."
